Dear Pastors, Church Families, and Praying Friends,

The short story is the new truck has been in the shop since the first week we received it, and is currently awaiting the replacement of the engine! I will send out a short update at the conclusion of this adventure detailing the fullness of God's blessing, but I will share for now that we have seen God's amazing hand at work throughout this process, and we praise Him for it!

We have had the privilege of working with Commonground Baptist Camp throughout the entire month of July! CBC is a ministry of Southeast Bible Baptist Church in Penfield, NY, and is directly overseen by Pastor Jim Krohn, who spends each week at the campground the church rents in Butler, PA serving alongside the staff as they minister to young people. CBC provides a Christ honoring, affordable, modestly attired, preaching centered camp experience! You may have noticed that those descriptors actually spell out CAMP, and they represent the values CBC upholds in their ministry. This year, they celebrated their 25th year of camp! GRBC has supported and sent our Juniors and Teens to this excellent camp for several years, and Angela and I have enjoyed serving as councilors for a few of those years. As part of the celebration, we were invited to smoke and serve brisket for the councilors as a way to show the camp's appreciation to them. Each of the four weeks, we arrived on Thursday afternoon with beef, served the meat at dinner, and stayed for the preaching services that night and the closing service the next morning. The second week, Bro. Micah McCurry, the Executive Director of Bible Tracts, Inc. and the Camp Evangelist for CBC, invited me to participate as a judge in a fun event he was facilitating for the camp staff; a "Chopped" style cooking competition! The event was on Sunday evening. The camp staff, who stay on the grounds each weekend, attend morning service at a local church near Butler, then hold an afternoon/evening service on the grounds. Bro. Caleb Krohn, the Camp Director, invited me to preach the afternoon service before the competition. It was a wonderful time of fellowship, and Angela and I were extremely impressed with the quality of the food prepared and presented by the staff, who are mostly teens and a few young adults! We appreciate Commonground not only allowing us to be part of their celebration and the behind the scenes aspects this month, but also how generously they cared for us while we stayed with them each week! Commonground relies heavily on the financial support and prayer partnership of local churches.
