Dear Pastors, Church Families, and Praying Friends,



They allowed us to stay in their comfortable prophet's chamber, provided for our needs, and shared meals with us. It was wonderful to worship with them Sunday and Wednesday, and we enjoyed fellowshipping throughout the week. I appreciated Pastor Medlin inviting me to preach Wednesday evening. They were a blessing in a variety of ways, and we are thankful for their kindness and generosity.
